Holding a leadership position in the Texas Junior Red Angus Association is an important responsibility, not to be taken lightly. You will be the face of TJRAA as a representative of the Red Angus Breed, and the Texas Red Angus Association. Becoming a Junior Board member is a great opportunity for you to develop strong leadership and organizational skills. You will be involved in each TJRAA meeting at the Stock Shows and conference calls. You may be called upon to give a speech, participate in interview situations and assist the Texas Red Angus Association with shows, meetings or at sales sponsored by the TRAA. A resident of Texas.

### Application Guidelines:

- One-year terms, may be elected to serve a second term.
- No one person may hold positions on both the Board and Royalty.

### President:

- Must be a TJRAA member in good standing for a minimum of 2 years to be eligible to run.
- Age 17-21 as of June 1<sup>st</sup> of the election year.
- Must have held an Officer position the previous year to be eligible to run.

### Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Reporter, Social Media:

- Must be a TJRAA member in good standing for a minimum of 2 years to be eligible to run.
- Age 14 – 21 as of June 1<sup>st</sup> of election year.
- Have served one year as a Director or Officer

### Director:

- Must be a TJRAA member in good standing for at least 1 year to be eligible to run
- Age 12 – 21 as of June 1<sup>st</sup> of election year.

**Queen:** Must be a TJRAA member in good standing minimum of 2 years, age 17-21 as of June 1<sup>st</sup> contest year

**Princess:** Must be a TJRAA member in good standing minimum of 1 year, age 13-16 as of June 1<sup>st</sup> contest year

**Sweetheart:** Must be a TJRAA member in good standing, age 8-12 as of June 1<sup>st</sup> contest year

### Election process will be based on a 100-point system.

- Application – 20 points
- 10 Question Breed Quiz – 40 points
- Popular Vote – 10 points
- Interview – 30 points

Attendance is required at the following TRAA/TJRAA events: TJRAA State Show, Field Day, Fort Worth Junior Show, Houston Junior Show. The Leadership Team will assist with all fundraisers and any other duties deemed necessary to ensure the success of the TJRAA. Conduct disrespectful of the office and organizations will result in removal from position as determined by the TRAA/TJRAA Executive Committee.
