Application Guidelines:

- One-year terms, may be elected to serve a second term.
- No one person may hold positions on both the Board and Royalty.

President:

- Must be a TJRAA member in good standing for a minimum of 2 years to be eligible to run.
- Age 17-21 as of June 1st of the election year.
- Must have held an Officer position the previous year to be eligible to run.

Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Reporter, Social Media:

- Must be a TJRAA member in good standing for a minimum of 2 years to be eligible to run.
- \triangleright Age 14 21 as of June 1st of election year.
- ➤ Have served one year as a Director or Officer

Director:

- Must be a TJRAA member in good standing for at least 1 year to be eligible to run
- ➤ Age 12 21 as of June 1st of election year.

Queen: Must be a TJRAA member in good standing minimum of 2 years, age 17-21 as of June 1st contest year **Princess**: Must be a TJRAA member in good standing minimum of 1 year, age 13-16 as of June 1st contest year **Sweetheart**: Must be a TJRAA member in good standing, age 8-12 as of June 1st contest year

Election process will be based on a 100-point system.

- ➤ Application 20 points
- ➤ 10 Question Breed Quiz 40 points
- ➤ Popular Vote 10 points
- ➤ Interview 30 points

Attendance is required at the following TRAA/TJRAA events: TJRAA State Show, Field Day, Fort Worth Junior Show, Houston Junior Show. The Leadership Team will assist with all fundraisers and any other duties deemed necessary to ensure the success of the TJRAA. Conduct disrespectful of the office and organizations will result in removal from position as determined by the TRAA/TJRAA Executive Committee.
